

Mission of St Paul's Outreach Ministry: To reach outside our doors to provide St Paul's neighbors with food, clothing and shelter.

Outreach Ministry Projects:

1. Supporting the work of Crossover Outreach with a fund raiser. Since 2020 with Covid restrictions and closure of the Masonic Temple dining room we were unable to have a chicken dinner. A new fund raiser will need to be developed.
2. Host church for Family Promise of Genesee County. St Jude and St Dunstan are support Congregations. House homeless families for one week 4 times a year. Provide breakfast, snacks, and an evening meal as well as a place to sleep. Hopefully families will be staying at churches beginning in Oct of 2021.
3. In August purchase a food truck from the Food Bank to distribute food. Due to numerous food programs and stimulus money we will not be getting truck for 2021.
4. Support Humane Society with Blessing of Animals in connection with St Francis of Assisi Day.
5. Provide Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas food baskets for Crossover Outreach patrons.
6. Provide Christmas gifts for military personnel.
7. Support Angel Tree gifts for 20 children from Crossover and one family from Family Promise
8. Provide funds for a child to go to Camp Chickagami. Camp is not open in 2021. Will provide overnight accommodations, breakfast and evening meal for counselors for a day camp at Memorial Park on Grand Traverse Street Flint, Mi for St Paul's children and children of families served at Crossover Outreach.

Outreach Ministry has been meeting via zoom and now also in-person on the Second Tuesday of the month at 4:30 pm. Any parishioner is welcome to attend.
