

Minutes of Outreach Committee, St. Paul's Episcopal Church
Date: July 15, 2022

Present: Karen Schaefer, Maggie Hart, Barbara Mannor, David Taylor, Betty Anne Taylor.

Also present: Tom Shriver, Denise Diller, Tiffany Sommers

Karen Schaefer called the meeting to order at 12:00 PM. David Taylor led with prayer.

The minutes of the June 17, 2022, meeting were unanimously approved with corrections. Betty Anne Taylor made the motion to approve the minutes and Maggie Hart seconded the motion.

Karen Schaefer introduced our guests representing Crossover Outreach: Tiffany Sommers, Denise Diller and Tom Shriver. They explained the many services Crossover provides the community of Flint and gave us a handout summarizing their ministries together with plans for their new building. Their antiquated headquarters no longer meets their needs. Most of the funding for the new building has been acquired. To fund the remaining \$300,000 for construction of the \$2 million facility, naming opportunities are being offered for parts of the building at different price ranges. The visitors left and the committee discussed the presentation, after which David Taylor made the motion to recommend to the vestry that St. Paul's Episcopal Church help Crossover Outreach through fundraising aiming for the \$25,000 dollar request. Barbara Mannor seconded and the motion carried.

After hearing Barbara Mannor's report on the details concerning the ice cream social in August, David Taylor made the motion that the Outreach Committee would not take the lead on the social, but individuals would be available to help as needed. Maggie Hart seconded the motion. Approved unanimously.

Barbara Mannor updated the committee on the Camp Chick Summer Camp activities. The first pre-camp party was a success. The second one for the older campers will be held on July 20, 2022, in Barth Hall from 11 AM till 1 PM. The camp bus will pick up campers beginning at 10 AM Sunday, July 17 in the alley behind the church. The bus plans to leave at 11 AM. Father Don is planning on blessing the campers before they leave.

On July 23 and July 30, the bus returns the campers to St Paul's, Barbara Mannor asked for a volunteer to be there with Terrance Whitehead to greet the campers and help them as they reconnect with their parents. David and Betty Anne Taylor volunteered to help for both dates.

The committee decided more research needs to be done about the St. Paul's tablecloth design for events. Karen Shaefer will contact Celeste Lord about changing the design to the side of the cloth and color options.

The discussion about the Outreach Mission Statement was postponed till next month's meeting.

Under New Business, David Taylor presented a brief summary of the Priceless Dreams ministry which focuses on financial

education. He will send an email to Father Don with details of the ministry and the contact information of the Priceless Dreams administrator.

Betty Anne Taylor motioned to dismiss the meeting at 1:35 PM. Barbara Mannor seconded the motion. Approved unanimously.

The meeting closed with The Lord's Prayer.
