Another year is behind us and a few projects were completed. Thanks to all the parishioners who helped this past year. Below is a list of the accomplishments (not in any specific order):

- Roofing, painting, gutter work
- Mortar fixed on outside of building
- Fixed water leaks in all bathrooms; also hot water in toilets fixed
- Replaced hot water heater
- Replaced carpet in the apartment
- Dishwasher serviced (currently getting bids for a new one as this one is approximately 20 years old)
- Ice maker serviced (compressor is broken, a new is needed, approximately 20 years old)
- Parish came together and did a deep clean in several areas on the inside of the church
- Worked outside for a community clean up
- Provided materials for an outside group to clean the church
- Audio and live streaming put into place
- Replaced a receptacle, plugs, switches, and burned out bulbs in sconces
- Bought a little green pro machine – used to clean all the chairs in Barth Hall
- Fixed closers on wood doors to Barth Hall
- Replaced leaky faucet in kitchen
- Fixed a leaky pipe under the nave
- Security system – getting quotes, a way to allow access to the building once a person is known to be present (i.e. camera & buzz system in Barth Hall)
- Phone system – bids received (phone system is old and occasionally stops working)
- Lighting in the nave fixed
- Floor lock on front wooden door – waiting for weather to break
