Month #1:

One month now officially in the books. There have been a number of accomplishments and some un-accomplishments (see prayer list below). Chief among the accomplishments is the progress made with Family Promise. As of this writing, our proposed building use agreement is under review at the attorneys. Whether we receive it in time for the meeting or not, I will propose the following motion:

“That the vestry approve the building use agreement [with any deletions, additions or re-phrasing as suggested by the attorneys] between St. Paul’s Episcopal Church and Family Promise of Genesee County”

Prayer List:

Rerun from last month: “It is my plan to transition to a clip-board based approach to maintaining a parish prayer list. The basic idea is that individuals would sign the clipboard (providing key information) from which Karein would then transfer to a master list. The establishment of the list is step one. How to implement the actual prayers will require some discussion/discernment.”

Communities First:

The main agenda item for this meeting is to have a discussion and consideration the Communities First/Consumers Power Easement request. I have allotted 30 minutes on the agenda for this purpose.
